The Anne Hutchinson School will dedicate Tuesday, October 25th as Make a Difference Day. In collaboration with Grace's Kitchen, we would like each student to bring in a nutritionally, balanced, brown bag lunch for a child, family, or senior in need. The lunches need to be brought into school on the morning of October 25th. These lunches will be collected by Student Council and delivered to Grace Church that day. We are hoping to get 100% participation.

Grace's Kitchen is the largest soup kitchen in White Plains. It is the only soup kitchen where the hungry can regularly get a nutritionally, balanced, free meal every Monday through Friday. The kitchen feeds between 50 and 140 individuals daily. This year almost 20,000 meals will be served. The mission of Grace's Kitchen is to provide a meal to anyone in need. Another important benefit is the companionship and compassion that each person receives in a safe and secure environment. Individuals who come to Grace's Kitchen often stay after finishing their meal to chat with friends, and to enjoy the sense of camaraderie that is missing from so many of their lives.

Please join us on Tuesday, October 25th as we volunteer together to make a difference in the lives of people right here in our own community.
