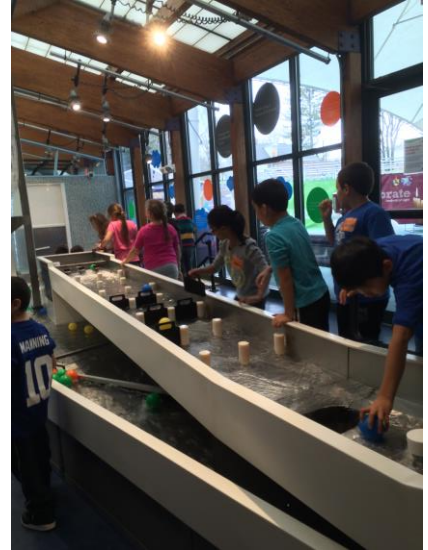


### 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Visits Stepping Stone Museum
